

Important generator safety tips:



Only use generators outside at least 20 feet away from your home. Do not use near doors. windows and vents, and make sure to direct the exhaust away from your home.



Never plug generators into a wall outlet. This causes backfeed. which occurs when power is sent back through your home's electrical lines in reverse. It creates a dangerous level of electricity that puts our crews at risk of severe injury.



Use a heavy-duty extension cord designed for outdoor use to connect appliances to the generator. Make sure the extension cord is free of cuts or tears and has a wattage rating that exceeds the total wattage of items plugged in.
